



## Custom enamel kitchenware

### SPECIFICATION FOR GRAPHICS

1. Open the “Custom Enamelware Catalogue” on the page 18 and click on the chosen dish to get the dieline.
2. Open the downloaded Dieline (which is the .pdf file) in Adobe Illustrator or other software which supports vector graphics files.
3. All available colors are in the Dielines. Drag-and-drop the on the kitchenware. Use only colors that are available in our file.
4. Add your graphics to the Dieline. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Graphics inside the dish can be only in black and white. “Inside” means all surfaces that might have contact with food. Graphics outside can be only in colors from Pantone Solid Coated up to 7000.
5. The minimum detail size is 0,2mm, so all elements and free spaces must be at least 0,2mm thick.
6. Fonts must be converted to curves.
7. Avoid gradient and transparency.
8. Save the graphics as a vector in .pdf, .eps or .ai file.
